

Harmony

Type and composition:

Miticide and Insecticide contains 7.2% w/v Etoxazole + 26.4% w/v Fenpropathrin in the form Emulsifiable Concentrate (EC).

Mode of Action:

Non-systemic Miticide and Insecticide.

Advantage and properties:

Harmony: Etoxazole Contact Miticide. Appears to inhibits moulting of mites and aphids.

Fenproprethein non-systemic insecticide and Miticide with contact and stomach action.

Harmony: Compatible with most commonly used pesticides, should be tested prior to mixing commercial quantities.

Harmony: Non-phytotoxic to most plant species when used as recommended.

Harmony: Harmful if inhaled, Harmful if swallowed, Causes eye injury, Very Toxic to aquatic life, Very Toxic to bees.
